Repeat dose **every 4 hours** while symptoms last.

Do NOT give more than 5 doses in 24 hours.

Do **NOT** use with any other product containing acetaminophen.

Use only the dosing device (syringe or dosing cup) that came with the product unless directed by a healthcare provider.

## Remind patients:

Read & follow the label on all **TYLENOL®** products.

Do  $\ensuremath{\text{NOT}}$  use with any other product containing acetaminophen.

Wait the right amount of time between doses
